The Standard Verifier will:

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- Attend and complete annual training and standardization
- Follow the protocols set out in the Quality Assurance Handbook
- Review centres' systems, delivery plans and resource management
- Undertake sampling of candidates' work within defined parameters and rules to verify that assessment outcomes, assessment and internal verification processes meet standards
- Assess and communicate the level of risk associated with centres' programmes and take actions according to that level of risk
- Provide sector-specific support, advice and guidance to centres
- Produce reports for centres and Pearson on the: sampling undertaken; outcomes reached and support provided
- Produce targeted and supportive actions for centres to assist with remedial action where standards are not being upheld
- Maintain service-level agreements
- Provide source materials for the standardisation of standards verifiers, centre assessors, internal verifiers and lead internal verifiers, as requested
- Work closely with the WBL Assessment team, undertake any other duties appropriate to the work of WBL Assessment, in relation to this role
