

# International Qualifications Trainer – Frequently Asked Questions

## How do I apply and what is the selection process?

If you would like to apply for this role please complete our online application form via the vacancy page on our website or link provided. You may also be required to complete a short video interview, the details of which will be sent to you once you have submitted your application. If you are shortlisted for the role, you will be asked to attend an assessment day at one of our international offices.

### What would my time commitment be?

International trainers will be expected to conduct between 5-10 days of training delivery / facilitating peer learning events.

## How frequently will I be required to travel?

Trainers will be expected to travel to and from events in order to carry out observations of face to face training. Training will take place all across your selected region and you should be prepared to make your own travel arrangements.

#### What training will I need to attend?

All Trainers will be required to attend an induction, annual trainer conference and be observed at least once per annum. Please contact the International team for specific dates.

#### How much can I expect to get paid?

Trainers will receive a standard rate £250 for full day delivery, and £200 for a half day or online event.
