

Frequently Asked Questions

What is a Qualification Development reviewer?

The Qualification Development department contract a subject or sector specialist to review written qualifications or units for vocational and general qualifications. These qualifications can be from Entry through to Level 7.

How do I apply and what is the selection procedure?

Please visit our web site: www.edexcel.com/aa-recruitment and fill out our online application form. References will be requested upon submission of the form. Once references are received, your form will then be assessed to ensure that you hold the required qualifications and experience.

I have already worked with Pearson on a contract basis. Do I need to reapply?

If you have not been contracted to work for the Qualifications Department within the last four years then you will need to reapply.

Can I apply for more than one area?

If you are interested in applying to be a reviewer for different subjects, you have three subject options. Each subject option will be considered against whether you have relevant subject knowledge, your level of sector experience and/or teaching experience in that sector.

How can I check on the progress of my application?

You can check on the status of your application at any time by logging into your Gateway account. Go to www.edexcelgateway.com, where you have the option to resume incomplete applications and view any applications previously submitted.

When would I need to be available and what would my time commitment be?

If you are successful in your application we can negotiate availability and advise upon dates. Your time commitment would vary depending on the contract and ideally we would like you to be flexible.

When can I expect to hear about whether or not I've been successful in my application?

You will be informed of the outcome of your application within six weeks of your application.

How much will I get paid?

Payment for each piece of work will vary and will depend on the amount of work that is involved.
